## Pricing

Tuition is paid on or before the first night. Tuition assistance and payment plans are available as needed. Students who need just a class or two can *Audit* courses without the formality of pursuing a degree. No exams or homework will be required. However, the cost for taking a class for credit or non-credit does not change. The withdrawal procedure and prorated refund is also the same for taking a class for credit or non-credit.

## Payment Plan

Students may spread tuition payments by paying 10% down upon registration, 25% by the 1st class, 50% by the 4<sup>th</sup> class, 75% by the 8<sup>th</sup> class, and 100% by the 12<sup>th</sup> class. Books must be paid in full upon receipt.

## Penalties

Students may withdraw anytime but will forfeit the 10% paid at registration. Tuition refunded will be pro-rated according to the number of days attended. Students with open accounts may not take final exams, receive course credit, or graduate.

The *Survey of Biblical Studies* program is a three-year study that walks through the entire Bible and 12 major doctrines. No prerequisites are required.

The *Biblical Counseling* programs, *Certificate*, *Bachelor*, and *Master* levels, are designed to equip students with biblical answers to tough counseling issues.

The *Bachelor of Biblical Studies and Ministry* program is for those desiring a four-year college education or for someone changing vocations. This program is tailored for bi-vocational preachers, teachers, or missionaries who want to acquire ministry skills and Bible knowledge.

The Master level is for those with a Bachelor degree from any discipline who need biblical and ministerial cross-training. The *Master of Biblical Studies* and *Master of Ministry* are two programs of 16 classes (48 credit hours) each. To earn the 96-hour *Master of Divinity* degree, the student must complete the *Master of Biblical Studies* and *Master of Ministry* programs.
